




 Master plan was approved by Missoula City Council in November 2019

PROJECT INPUT + DESIGN PROCESS




MASTER PLAN RECOMMENDATIONS

- Building continuity between master plan elements and existing sections of Mary Jane Boulevard




MARY JANE - RECOMMENDED DESIGN

- The addition of bike lanes will allow for increased bike path connectivity and a safer commute for all users.
- This aligns with public feedback collected during the Mullan Area Master Plan and allows for the addition of protected bike lanes.
- Parking on the east side of Mary Jane Boulevard from Melrose Place to Camden Street will be removed.
- Cost sensitive solution utilizes existing street with no impact to greenspace.
- Designing with future growth in mind.

Construction begins on prioritized areas in 2022.

Work on Mary Jane Boulevard will occur in 2022 and 2023 with the majority taking place in 2023.
