Mullan BUILD Groundbreaking Event

City, County, consultants thank stakeholders

MISSOULA, MONTANA (April 18, 2022) – Missoula County, in partnership with the City of Missoula, broke ground on the first phase of the Mullan BUILD project in April.

Now that Missoula County has officially completed the Federal Highway Administration grant agreement and received BUILD grant funding, the project team is hosting an event for stakeholders, elected officials and local representatives to thank them for their participation in the project.

The groundbreaking event will take place at noon on Thursday, April 21, at the north end of Mary Jane Boulevard, where it meets Camden Street. Missoula community members, local and federal elected officials, neighborhood council representatives, county commissioners and all who played a part in applying for funding or moving the BUILD project toward construction are invited to the event.

"This project has been years in the making," Missoula County Public Works Director-Shane Stack said. "Before this even became a true project, we worked with dozens of community members in Missoula to apply for the funding in the first place. We would not have gotten to this point without their support."

The event will feature a handful of speakers and is scheduled to take less than an hour. Media representatives are welcome.
